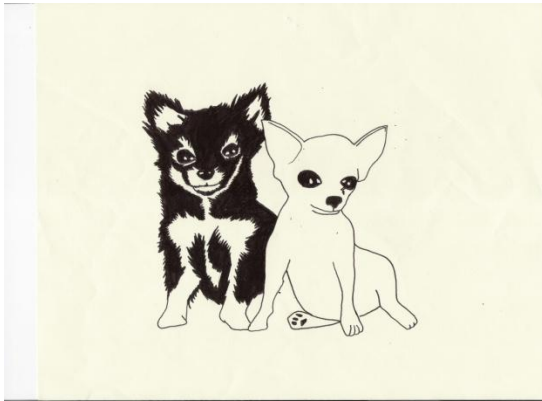

Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries

Stud Dog Class: Entry fee \$30.00. For stud dog and two of its get. Stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its get. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Produce for Get

Brace Class: (Two, both dogs must have at least one common owner). The fee for the brace as a unit is \$30.00. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of entry. In making entries for 'Brace Class Only', full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a regular class or for Best of Breed Competition and entered as a part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes - 'Brace Class'. If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must be so designated - 'Brace No. 1', 'Brace No. 2' etc.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one animal, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Puppy Sweepstakes

Entry fee for the Puppy Sweepstakes is \$10.00 per entry. All entries must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Champions of Record are eligible for the Puppy Sweepstakes. There is no restriction on Professional Handlers showing dogs.

Class Division for Sweepstakes

Puppy Bitches, 6 months and under 9 months
Puppy Bitches, 9 months and under 12 months

Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as follows:

40% for First Place	20% for Third Place
30% for Second Place	10% for Fourth Place

Junior Showmanship Competition

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE (919) 854-0195.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * No space will be provided for unentered dogs and no unentered dogs will be allowed on the show grounds.
- * Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted after entries have closed. Entries close on Wednesday, July 7 at 5:00 PM
- * All entries are to be mailed with fees to: Lauren A. Payne, 10 Ahern Ave, Windsor Locks, CT 06096. Entries received without fees and/or signature will not be accepted.
- * All checks and money orders are to be made payable to the Hudson Valley Chihuahua Club.
- * All checks and money orders MUST be payable in US funds.
- * Entries not on official AKC entry forms are not acceptable.
- * An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 (first entry only) and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for each entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)
- * The show will be open from 8 AM to 5:00 PM.
- * Dogs may arrive any time before the scheduled time of judging.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If, because of riot, civil disobedience or other acts beyond control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- * Errors on entry blanks are the responsibility of the person making out the form. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such error after the published closing date.
- * Cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Both the Club and the Show Secretary disclaim any responsibility for cash prizes after the judging of the show is over.
- * Neither the Club nor the Show Secretary will be responsible for loss or damage to any dog entered, nor for the possessions of any exhibitor or spectator. It is distinctly understood that every dog is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient in consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies. I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants
